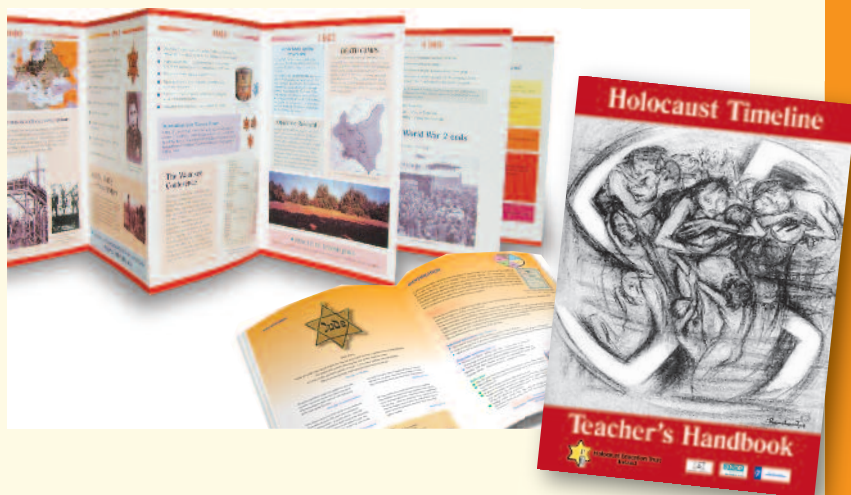


# The Holocaust Narrative

**A presentation that gives an overview of the development of the Holocaust before, during and after World War II**

## OUTLINE

This presentation is suitable for senior cycle students of any subject ranging from: History, Transition Year, English, RE, Mathematics, CSPE, Media Studies and Languages and others.



## DURATION

The seminar takes 90 minutes and includes images, readings, testimonies and materials. Ideally, it works very well if we can allow extra time to accommodate questions and discussion afterwards.

## AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The programme is designed to give participants an understanding of the depth and complexity of the Holocaust, in an accessible format.

Only by understanding the context in which the Holocaust took place, can we begin to understand what was wiped away. Two thirds of the Jewish population of Europe was murdered as well as hundreds of thousands of other victims. What was Europe like for Jews before the Holocaust? And what happened to the survivors afterwards? Who were the Righteous Among The Nations? What role did bystanders play? Did antisemitism stop with the end of the war? Was there any resistance to the Nazis?
